- Provide two (2) letters of recommendation from nonfamily members (preferred sources: Church, Community Organization, Teacher or Counselor) by June 9, 2025.
- Wear required conservative formal attire at the ball and appropriate attire to scheduled events.
- Father/parental representative and Escort wear required conservative formal attire at the ball.
- Sign, along with parent(s) or legal guardian(s), the Cotillion Agreement, Agreement of Scholarship Funds Disbursement and Release of Liability Forms
